Networking Limousin Influenced Cattle

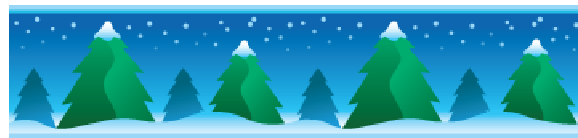
